

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK





INTRODUCTION : Few words about the college :

The origin of the Mandia Anchalik College dates away back to 1981. It was the long cherished dream of the local people who were aspirants of higher education for their offsprings. The intense desires and untiring efforts of our founding fathers lit the light when the college started its first academic session in September 1981 with arts faculty only under a thatched roof in the premises of the then Mandia High School with the eminent educationist and Ex-minister of Govt. of Assam, late Atuar Rahman as the principal. Since then, the college has been imparting higher education among the youths of this backward and remote area. The selfless devotion and sacrifice of the local people have ushered the college to the present position and even today their efforts are on so that the college can emerge as a unique institute in higher education scenario of the state.

The college, being affiliated to Gauhati University, has been imparting higher education in one programme i.e. Under Graduate (U.G.) programme. The college has been accredited in Grade 'C' by NAAC in the year 2004. Presently, the college is working on preparation to invite NAAC for Accreditation and Assessment once again.

Course fee will be decided by the College authority.

T.D.C. in the SEMESTER SCHEME :

Semester system has been introduced in the T.D.C. (1+1+1) course for the first time from the academic session i.e. 2011-2012, Accordingly one academic session is divided into two semesters of six months duration each. Hence there will be six semesters in total for three year degree course.

Key Points of Semester System :

- ➔ A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular semester. Three chances means, three continuous examinations of a particular semester irrespective of a student appears or not. For example, a student of 2014 batch will get three chances i.e. in 2014, 2015 and 2016, thus, student shall have to complete his/her all papers of 1st Semester Examination in 2016.
- ➔ Students can apply for repeat examination in one of the theory papers in 1st, 2nd and 3rd semester examinations. The provision for repeat examination is not applicable for 4th, 5th and 6th semester examination.
- ➔ Re evaluation of answer scripts should be addressed to the Deputy Controller of Examination, G.U. through the Principal within 15 days from the date of declaration of results of the respective examination.
- ➔ Students passing in any paper(s) of a semester need to appear in the remaining papers (Failed or not appeared) in the next examination. Students passing in practical paper(s) of a subject need to appear only in theory paper(s) in the subsequent examination.
- ➔ It is mandatory for all students to appear in Sessional Examinations. The minimum mark for passing in each paper is 30% of the total marks.
- ➔ Subject correction and switch over cases from Major to General course is allowed in 1st Semester only. Students applying for switch over from major to general course need to send the information immediately before the examination form fill up.
- ➔ Application Form for Name Correction, Withheld Result Clearance, Subject Correction, Duplicate Grade Sheet/ Mark Sheet, Admit Card, Re-evaluation of Answer Scripts etc. may be downloaded from G.U. Website (www.gauhati.ac.in) and to be submitted to the principal of the respective colleges along with necessary documents and fees.
- ➔ (Date of Examination Form fill up and Examination schedule of all semesters to be displayed separately)



Important Information for Students

Performance of the Semester Course students shall be monitored throughout the Semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical course. Evaluation of the students' performance in both theory and practical paper will be based on the following criteria.

Internal Evaluation : 20% marks

External Evaluation : 80% marks

Internal evaluation will be based on sessional examinations, home assignments, seminars, group discussion and library work in each semester. External evaluation shall be done through final examination under G.U. programme at the end of each semester. In each paper, students must have to secure pass marks on both internal and external evaluation.

Students shall have to attend about 30 hours of contact teaching per week which will be considered the completion of minimum 30 credit point week in a semester.

However class attendance must be at least 75% of the classes throughout the semester, less than that shall debar a students from appearing in the final examination as a regular student. Apart from regular classes tutorial classes will be held dividing the students into several groups, if required.

Admission Procedure :

Procedure of admission into all the courses begins with the notification issued by the Principal immediately after the announcement of respective results. Prospectus and Admission Form can be collected from the college office on payment of the prescribed fee and the intending candidates are required to submit the filled in Application Forms within the stipulated time limit. The applications are processed and finalized by the Admission Board/Academic Committee of the college. The selected candidates are to appear before the Admission Board **with all particulars in original on the date and day fixed for the admission.**



ELIGIBILITY NORMS:

The eligibility norms for submission of applications for admission into various courses are as follows :

1. H.S. Course (Arts) : HSLC or equivalent recognised examination passed.
2. T.D.C. Course (Arts) : H.S. or equivalent examination in any stream passed.

DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION :

Admission forms must be submitted with the following supporting documents/particulars :

- (i) Attested copies of all certificate and marks-sheets.
- (ii) Pass and character certificate from the Head of the Institution attended last.
- (iii) HSLC Admit card for verification of age.
- (iv) Students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PH/OSP must have to enclose certificate of respective caste.(if any)
- (v) Gap certificate from competent authority, if required.
- (vi) Students from Boards or Universities other than SEBA, AHSEC or GU shall have to produce migration certificate at the time of admission.

ATTENDANCE:

Attendance is compulsory in all classes. Students shall have to attend at least 75% of lectures for theoretical and practical classes separately to become eligible to sit for the Final Examination, else will be treated as disqualified.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

A student failing to attend classes for 30 (Thirty) days at a stretch, his or her admission shall be cancelled.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

The college follows the regulations prepared by AHSEC and GU which is also the subject of change from time to time in respect of concerned courses.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- ➔ Every pupil of the institution & all-intra institutional bodies shall be subject to general guidance and control as may be prescribed by the College Governing Body from time to time.
- ➔ Any student, found to have involved in anti academic activity, disobedient or indecent in his or her behaviour with the teaching and non-teaching staff, shall be subject to disciplinary action.
- ➔ A student who is found to have violated college rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- ➔ Admission Fee and all other fees are to be paid at a time for the whole year on the day of admission.
- ➔ Each academic session will run as per Academic Calendar embodied in the prospectus.
- ➔ Wearing of college uniform is compulsory during college hours on all working days including days of College Week, Meetings and Examination etc.
- ➔ Identity Card supplied from the college should be kept with students inside the college.
- ➔ Mobile phones are strictly restricted during class and examination hours. Any violation is subject to severe disciplinary action.



- ➔ Spitting/smoking/ writing on walls, doors and dirtying in any way in and around the college building is strictly prohibited. Any student detected doing so is subject to exemplary disciplinary action.
 - ➔ No notice or leaflet can be circulated in college premises without due permission of the Principal.
 - ➔ Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found involved in any form of ragging inside the college campus shall be viewed as per Govt. Law.
 - ➔ Committee constituted by the Principal under his/her chairmanship will be competent authority to prohibit ragging.
 - ➔ Ragging may invite the following action to curb the menace.
 - (i) Criminal offence as per law passed by a number of state governments.
 - (ii) Rustication from the college.
 - (iii) Embossment on Marks sheet, Degree certificate etc.
 - (iv) Penalty and imprisonment of one year. (v) Fine.
- In the event of any complaint regarding ragging no one can plead in favour of accused or to be excused from punitive action.
